

**Nominating Committee  
Space Coast Meeting  
December 16, 2001**

After Meeting for Worship and a period of silence, at Orlando Park, Lyn Cope-Robinson, David Robinson, Martha Robinson, Gail Rogers, Ariel Rogers, Jack Deppner, and Barbara Deppner convened for a meeting of the whole in order to function as a nominating committee.
